



In Person Winter Classes for Children, Teens and Adults Begin January 30

The Center's unique curriculum of children's art classes, in person at The Center, allows young artists to enroll in in-depth classes designed to deepen and develop skills in a single medium. Classes for ages 5-8 include Mixed Media, Pottery, Painting in Depth, and Drawing in Depth. Classes for ages 9-11 include Art in 3 Dimensions, Drawing in Depth, Painting in Depth, and Pottery. Teens can choose from Collage Art, Drawing Intensive, Paper Sculpture & Light Boxes or Pottery.

Classes for children with Autism Spectrum Disorder and other special needs are offered in person at The Center on Monday afternoons beginning January 30, and provide guided experiences that foster communication, creativity, and problem solving with hands-on activities.

In person, select hybrid, and virtual classes are offered for adults with all levels of expertise in a variety of media including oil and acrylic paint, pastel, watercolor, drawing, and ceramics. Classes for adults begin January 17.
