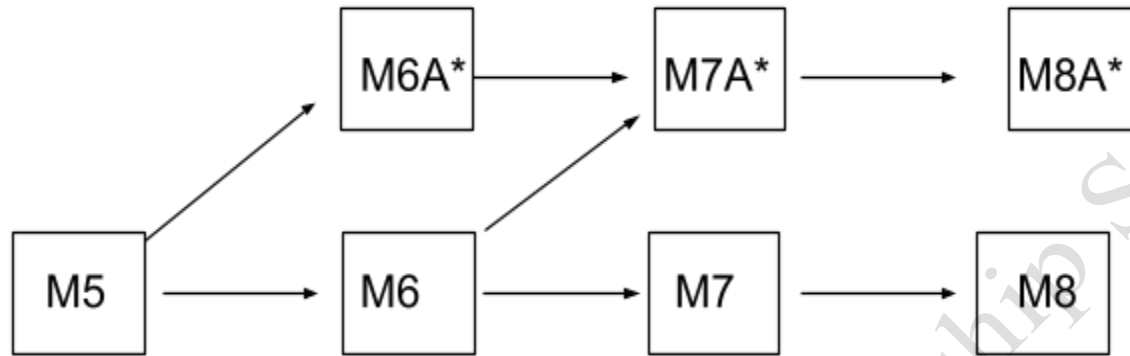
Points for placement

Options Based on Placement Criteria

- A. Grade 5 students who have completed Math 5 will have the following option(s) based on placement criteria.
 - a. Math 6
 - b. Math 6A (Math 7)
- B. Grade 6 students who have completed Math 6 will have the following option(s) based on placement criteria.
 - a. Math 7
 - b. Math 7A (Pre-Algebra)
- C. Grade 6 students who have completed Math 6A will have the following option(s) based on placement criteria.
 - a. Math 7A (Pre-Algebra)
- D. Grade 7 students who have completed Math 7 will have the following option based on placement criteria.
 - a. Math 8 (Pre-Algebra)
- E. Grade 7 students who have completed Math 7A will have the following option based on placement criteria.
 - a. Math 8A (Algebra)

- A course level of curriculum can only be skipped after Grade 5 or Grade 6.
- Students who do not qualify for an accelerated math program and would like to move into a different level may take an Exit Test scheduled on the second to last school day in June. There will be no exceptions to this date. There will be no make up dates for those students who are not in attendance for this exam.
- Since there is a great deal of testing in the math department, we recommend students take only Math Finals, not midterms and finals. With the exception of Algebra. That procedure should follow the high school.
