Classroom Clean Up Protocols & Practices

Staff Training Information

- The staff training for classroom cleanup was an electronically reviewable document highlighting the protocols in place at Bedminster Township School
- Staff was provided time during after school assigned PLC time to review the presentation and sign off on the google form
- In addition, the training provided staff with an understanding of the green products used by our custodial staff to clean the classrooms and common areas.
- The training provided delineation of responsibilities between classroom staff, students and district personnel to maintain and ensure a clean, healthy and safe environment for students, staff and community stakeholders.
