

NJ Audubon Summer Camp Open House

Learn about N.J. Audubon summer camps in Bernardsville

BERNARDSVILLE - New Jersey Audubon is hosting a free open house from 1 to 3 p.m. Sunday, March 8, at its Scherman Hoffman Wildlife Sanctuary at 11 Hardscrabble Road for residents to learn more about its summer nature camp programs.

Attendees will have the opportunity to view camp activities and pictures from years past and take a brief tour of the property. Scherman Hoffman Wildlife Sanctuary's summer day and overnight camp program is designed to foster environmental awareness and an appreciation for the natural world.

The program encourages direct experience with the natural world through hands-on learning, activities, games, crafts and nature exploration. During summer camp, the majority of the day is spent outside on the sanctuary's 300-acre property.

Day camps are offered for children age 4 to entering grade 6. Overnight camps are offered at the Delaware Water Gap and at the Barnegat Bay for children entering grades 6 through 10.

The Scherman Hoffman Wildlife Sanctuary provides educational programs throughout the year for adults and children.
