We're pleased to share details with you about our fundraising program for our 8th Grade trip to DC. It's called "scrip", and it's the fundraising program that works while you shop.

Scrip is simply a word that means "substitute money" – in other words, scrip is gift certificates from national and local retailers. They're the same gift certificates that you buy at the store. Many popular retailers participate in our scrip program including JCPenney, The Gap, Shell, Pizza Hut, Red Lobster and many, many others.

You're probably asking yourself how these stores help us raise money. It's simple -- scrip participating retailers agree to sell gift certificates to our organization at a discount. Member families like yours buy the certificates for full face value, they redeem them for full face value, and our school keeps the difference as revenue.

The beauty of scrip is that you put your regular household shopping dollars to work. You earn money for our school without spending a single additional penny. Just spend your regular shopping dollars with scrip at the stores that participate in the scrip program! And scrip can be used for just about any household purchase including food, clothing, entertainment, gasoline and even dining out.

How To Order Scrip Cards

Where Do I Start?

To purchase Scrip gift cards, you must register on the ShopWithScrip website. Place your order, check order history and track how much you raised for your child's Washington, DC trip!

Go to www.shopwithscrip.com

- Click on "Register" located in the top right corner
- Look for the blue square on the left hand side and click on "Join a Scrip Program". **Once you are registered you can just log in for future orders.**
- Enter the information as requested (*YOU, the parent are the primary name*). **Please enter your child's name and homeroom teacher** and click on "Accept Agreements".
- On the next page you will be asked what non-profit group you are associated with, you must enter the enrollment code **6DE977L43L492**. Make sure to enter it correctly so that you are identified with "Bedminster Board of Education".
- Click on "Place Order" to begin. On the "Shop" tab you can browse by category to look at what is available.
 - *Check out "What's New", where there are special offers with bonus rebates. Also, there are vendors that offer eGifts by email (ScripNow! Brands) and reloading on cards after initial purchase through the Scrip program (Reload Brands). Great as an eco- friendly choice!
- As you shop you will add items to your cart like other internet shopping sites.
- When you are finished adding items to your cart, review your order and click on "Checkout". FYI...the donated \$ total will appear on this page.
- Click on "Submit Order".
- Please print "Order Confirmation" and submit along with your payment. There is no need to check "How You Will Receive Order", we will deliver to the homerooms.

How Do I Pay?

- Checks made to "Bedminster Township BOE."
- Payments can be made either by dropping off at the school front desk or by sending in with your child to be collected during homeroom period.
- Please send payment in a sealed envelope clearly marked: **Scrip 8th Grade**

How Do I Receive My Order?

- Unless we receive alternative instructions, we will send your order to your child's homeroom on Friday of the following week.
