Internet Access & Telecommunications

- **Comcast:** Xfinity WiFi hotspots across the country will be available to anyone who needs them for free – including non-Xfinity Internet subscribers. For a map of Xfinity WiFi hotspots, visit www.xfinity.com/wifi. Once at a hotspot, consumers should select the “xfinitywifi” network name in the list of available hotspots, and then launch a browser. In addition, new customers will receive 60 days of complimentary Internet Essentials service (25 Mbps downstream and 3 Mbps upstream), which is normally available to all qualified low-income households, for \$9.95/month.
- **Altice (Optimum):** For households with K-12 and/or college students who may be displaced due to school closures and who do not currently have home internet access, Altice Advantage 30 Mbps broadband is being offered free for 60 days to any new customer household. Starting Monday, March 16, 2020, eligible households interested in this solution can call (866) 200-9522 to enroll.
- **Verizon:** Verizon is waiving overage fees and late charges for customers impacted by the COVID-19 crisis, and is automatically adding 15 GB of data for wireless consumer and small business customers (no action required). What is Closed in New Jersey?

In an effort to promote social distancing to limit the spread of the COVID-19 virus, the following are closed:

- K-12 public, private and parochial schools (as of 3/18)
- Universities (as of 3/18)
- Casinos
- Nightclubs
- Performing Arts Centers and other concert venues
- Racetracks
- Movie theaters
- Gyms and fitness centers
- Indoor malls (as of 3/17 at 8pm)
- Indoor amusement centers and amusement parks (as of 3/17 at 8pm)
- All non-essential retail, recreational and entertainment businesses after 8pm
- All barbershops and hair salons, spas, nail and eyelash salons, tattoo parlors and social clubs that cannot comply with social distancing guidelines (as of 3/19 at 8pm)

To mitigate the impact of COVID-19 and protect the capacity of New Jersey's health care system for the state's most vulnerable, Governor Phil Murphy has signed Executive Order No. 107, directing all residents to stay at home until further notice. The order provides for certain exceptions, such as obtaining essential goods or services, seeking medical attention, visiting family or close friends, reporting to work, or engaging in outdoor activities.

In an effort to strengthen the existing social distancing measures in place, the order also prohibits all gatherings of individuals, such as parties, celebrations, or other social events, unless otherwise authorized by the Order. When in public, individuals must practice social distancing and stay at least six feet apart whenever possible, excluding immediate family members, caretakers, household members, or romantic partners.

Governor Murphy's Executive Order further directs the closure of all non-essential retail businesses to the public, with the exceptions of:

- Grocery stores, farmer's markets and farms that sell directly to customers, and other food stores, including retailers that offer a varied assortment of foods comparable to what exists at a grocery store;
- Pharmacies and medical marijuana dispensaries;
- Medical supply stores;
- Gas stations;
- Convenience stores;
- Ancillary stores within healthcare facilities;
- Hardware and home improvement stores;
- Banks and other financial institutions;
- Laundromats and dry-cleaning services;
- Stores that principally sell supplies for children under five years;
- Pet stores;
- Liquor stores;
- Car dealerships, but only for auto maintenance and repair, and auto mechanics;
- Printing and office supply shops;
- Mail and delivery stores.
